Memory Verse: "The Lord is my shepherd." Psalm 23:1

Show your toddler the verse in your Bible. Help your toddler practice saying the memory verse. Use simple hand motions to help your child remember the verse. You can also use the provided sheep pictures with the verse to help your child practice.

Emphasize that the people and events in the Bible are real, and the Bible is the Word of God. Use the provided story teaching picture and story overview, read from a child's Bible, or tell the story in your own words.

BIBLE TIME for Toddlers

David Was a Shepherd Boy (1 Samuel 16:6-12; 17:12-15, 34-36)

David was a shepherd. He took care of his father's sheep. He led the sheep to green grass when they were hungry. What do you like to eat? He led them to cool water when they were hot and thirsty. Water is good for us, too. He led them to a safe place to lay down and sleep when they were tired. Would you like to sleep outside? David kept his sheep healthy and safe. Sometimes a wild animal like a bear or a lion would try to sneak up on the sheep to hurt one. Can you sound like a lion? What about a bear? David protected his sheep from lion s and bears. He had slingshot that he carried with him. If an animal tried to attack his sheep he would use his slingshot to scare it away. God takes care of us like a shepherd takes care of his sheep. God gives us food and water and a safe place to live. He gives us people to love us and keep us safe and healthy.

Games & Activities

Blocks

Ask you child to use blocks to make a pen for their toy sheep. Remind them that God takes care of us like a shepherd takes care of his sheep.

Game

Stand on the opposite side of the room as your toddler. When you call out "Sheep" your toddler can make a sheep sound and take one step forward. When you call out "lion" or "bear" your child should make that sound and take one step back. Keep playing until your child reaches you.

Matching Game

Turn the game cards face down. Teach your child to try to match the pictures by turning over two cards at a time.

Pretend

Play

Use a doll, stuffed animal, or action figure. Say, "It looks like your doll is hungry (thirsty/tired/scared, etc.). How you can you take care of him?"
