## HCDP Team Continues to Work and Remain Safe in Spite of Turmoil in Haiti



*I will lift up my eyes to the mountains-where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth. Psalm 121:1-2*

Political unrest and persecution have never been worse than now in Haiti. Most of the violence is in the capital, Port au Prince. The Pacius family and the HCDP staff remain safe. The city of Gonaives, where our work is based, is currently relatively quiet. Our school work in rural areas and at the local agricultural school is still ongoing. Travel has been disrupted, and the impact of fuel and food supplies create worsening food insecurity for the entire count. Our faithful servants continue to work and worship. Still, this is a stressful time with

great anxieties for our friends, not just for their own welfare, but for the welfare of their extended families in more difficult areas.
